## Law School Alumnus Named Evidence Summit Champion

FORT WORTH, Texas – Judge Carlos Cortez '95 was honored as the first-place winner of the first-ever Evidence Summit, held in Austin, Aug. 3-5.

Eight law schools participated in the 2008 Evidence Summit, which was designed for Texas judges by the Texas Center for the Judiciary's curriculum committee and was funded by a grant from the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals. The educational event brought together Texas judges and Texas law schools to compete for the title of 2008 Evidence Summit Champion.

Each participating law school and one judicial panel hosted one hour of "Evidence Jeopardy." The Texas Wesleyan University School of Law team consisted of Dean Frederic White, Professor Michael Green, and County Court Judge Dan Wilson '98.

Dean White said the event, which was his first exposure to a group of Texas judges since his arrival at the law school, was a great showcase of the talent at Texas Wesleyan University School of Law.

"The Evidence Summit was my first introduction to a group of Texas judges," White said. "They were friendly and engaged. I was happy to appear on the Texas Wesleyan Law panel along with Professor Michael Green and Judge Don Wilson. It was icing on the cake to find that one of our own, Judge Carlos Cortez '95, took first place!"
