Law School Co-Sponsors Contract Law Conference

FORT WORTH, Texas – Two Texas Wesleyan University School of Law professors will attend the Fourth International Conference on Contracts at the University of the Pacific McGeorge School of Law in Sacramento, Calif., Feb. 8-9, an event that brings together scholars who teach and work in the field of contract law.

Professors Wayne Barnes and Frank Snyder will attend the two-day conference, which is co-sponsored by Texas Wesleyan University School of Law. Snyder created the annual conference after he discovered that there was not an annual conference dedicated to contract law.

“I created the conference five years ago because there was no annual conference like it in my field,” Snyder said. “It's grown from around 20 presenters in 2002 to about 45 this year. I've been the lead organizer each year.”

Barnes will attend and participate as the moderator of a four-person panel titled Standard Form Contracting.

The conference brings together professionals who work and teach in the areas of contract law and practice, giving them the opportunity to attend panel discussions and presentations. One of the main goals of the conference is to foster and encourage relationships between colleagues throughout the field. It is unique in its wide coverage of contracts-related issues and mix of junior and senior-level scholars, and it is the largest annual conference devoted to contract law and scholarship.

Texas Wesleyan University School of Law has co-sponsored the conference in previous years with the University of Gloucester, and South Texas College of Law. The law school was the sole sponsor and host of the second conference.
