## Law School Welcomes Dean Frederic White

**FORT WORTH, Texas** – Members of the law school and legal communities gathered recently to welcome Dean Frederic White to Texas Wesleyan University School of Law, with receptions that were held at the law school's Bernie Schuchmann Conference Center.

The events took place during the first week of classes, with one for students and another for faculty, staff, alumni, and individuals from throughout the law school community.

The fall 2008 semester is Dean White's first at Texas Wesleyan. He took his place as the law school's fifth dean on July 21. He was previously the dean of Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco.

Dean White said his experience so far has been a positive one and that he looks forward to taking Texas Wesleyan University School of Law to the next level.

"The people at Texas Wesleyan and in the surrounding legal community have been incredibly welcoming since day one," Dean White said. "I have met so many people who are so excited about the future of our law school, and I could not be happier about the enthusiasm for what we are doing here. Dean White served as dean of Golden Gate University School of Law for four and a half years. He earned his J.D. from Columbia University School of Law, and his bachelor's degree from Columbia College.
