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### Local Attorneys Mentor Students

**FORT WORTH, Texas** – For the third year in a row, students at Texas Wesleyan School of Law have been paired with American Airlines attorneys as part of the Diversity Mentorship program.

Targeted at second- and third-year law students, the Diversity Mentorship program seeks to provide minority students with guidance and career advice from mentoring attorneys throughout the academic year. This year 12 students were paired with 12 attorneys.

“The American Airlines Law Student Diversity Mentorship Program offers a wonderful opportunity for our law students to gain insight and guidance on the practical aspects of the practice of law,” Arturo Errisuriz, assistant dean for career services said. “We are grateful to the AA attorneys for volunteering their time and are delighted to partner with them again this year.”
