Second Court of Appeals to Visit Law School

FORT WORTH, Texas – On Thursday, Oct. 30, 2008, a panel of the Second Court of Appeals will hear oral arguments at Texas Wesleyan University School of Law.

The court will hear arguments in two cases: *Sanders v. Comerica Bank, and Inc. and Ford v. State*. Arguments will begin at 10:30 am in the Amon G. Carter Lecture Hall. Students, faculty, and staff are welcome and encouraged to attend.

The Second Court of Appeals previously held oral arguments at the law school in 2005, 2006, and 2007. On occasion, the state's highest courts will visit law schools to allow students to observe how cases are handled in the state system.
