Two Adjunct Professors Elected to SBOT Positions

FORT WORTH, Texas – Texas Wesleyan University School of Law adjunct professors Roland Johnson and Joe Shannon, Jr. have been elected to serve on the State Bar of Texas (SBOT).

Johnson, of Harris, Finely, and Bogle, P.C., was elected to serve as president-elect, and will take office on June 26, at the annual meeting in Houston. He will serve his term as president for the 2009-10 bar year. Johnson is a past-president of the Tarrant County Bar Association and will be the first Tarrant County lawyer to serve at SBOT president since 1958.

Shannon, of the Tarrant County District Attorney's Office, was elected to serve as the Chair of the Board of Directors for SBOT. He is also a past-president of the Tarrant County Bar Association. He will begin his duties at the first board meeting following the annual meeting in Houston.
