### Two Students Awarded De Los Santos Scholarships

**FORT WORTH, Texas** – Members of the Texas Wesleyan School of Law Hispanic Law Students Association (HLSA) celebrated Mexican Independence Day on Sept 16. with the annual presentation of the Ricardo De Los Santos scholarship awards.
